In order to resolve enforcement issues, the applicant has agreed to a two year grant, with the condition that he not operate between 14.272 and 14.278 MHz.

The applicant has apparently operated unlicensed but we have no independent evidence of that and complainant information cannot be proven. Goldberg concedes that and has been candid with us, but without independent verification a hearing would be a waste of resources.

We recommend the conditional and short term grant pursuant to his signed agreement attached.
