

I recently became aware that Glenn Baxter (K1MAN) has been distributing unsolicited commercial email which uses my name in order to promote his business interests. On his website (k1man.com) which promotes IARN and AARA, he has posted a photograph of himself with me and my wife. I would like the FCC, and the public to know, that Mr. Baxter has no authorization to use my name, or my photograph, and that I do not support Mr. Baxter or any of his activities, business or otherwise.

I understand that the FCC has issued a fine in the amount of \$21,000 against Mr. Baxter's amateur station. Based on my personal understanding of the issues involved and the findings in the NAL, I support the Commission and I urge the FCC to deny the renewal of Glenn Baxter's amateur radio license.
